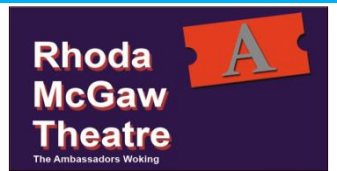

Our Summer Production is a unique summer holiday performance opportunity produced by The Biz Theatre School and Biz Productions, culminating in fully staged performances of **CATS** at The Rhoda McGaw Theatre in Woking. Following on from The Biz Theatre's critically acclaimed productions of Hairspray (2017) Into The Woods (2016), Phantom of The Opera (2015), Les Misérables (2014), Grease (2013), Footloose (2012), West Side Story (2011) etc, **CATS** will be our fourteenth youth production.

The Biz Theatre School and Biz Productions have consistently delivered high quality West End style performances, and as such we have achieved national recognition from our productions (please see our web site). With a top professional creative team to produce the show including Director and Producer Erika Vincent, and Musical Director Sam Coates, The Biz will once again hire in a professional set and employ a full live orchestra to ensure that our youth productions are always of the very best possible quality and an unforgettable experience for all of our young cast taking part. Once again we will be raising money for **SHOOTING STAR CHASE**.

Cats, one of the longest-running shows in West End and Broadway history, received its world premiere at the New London Theatre in 1981, where it played for 21 record-breaking years and almost 9,000 performances. The groundbreaking production was the winner of the Olivier and Evening Standard Awards for Best Musical. Cats has been presented in over 30 countries, translated into 16 languages and seen by more than 73 million people worldwide. Originally directed by Trevor Nunn and featuring musical staging by Gillian Lynne, the all-singing, all-dancing Tony-winning musical spectacular is set amongst a larger-than-life junkyard playground and is alive with purr-fect felines including Rum Tum Tugger, Mr. Mistoffelees, Macavity, Jennyanydots, Old Deuteronomy, Skimbleshanks and Grizabella. The Jellicle Cats come out to play on one special night of the year—the night of the Jellicle Ball. One by one they tell their stories for the amusement of Old Deuteronomy, their wise and benevolent leader, who must choose one of the Cats to ascend to The Heavise Layer and be reborn into a whole new Jellicle life.

REHEARSALS for **CATS** take place at Christ College, Guildford (first week) and at The Rhoda McGaw Theatre (second week) with three performances of **CATS** at the end of the 2 weeks. We have only 50 places available for young people aged 8-21 years to be in our cast of **CATS**. To audition for **CATS** you must be available for all rehearsal dates, between **Mon 13 – Sat 25 August 2018**. (N.B. We will not rehearse on the weekend of 18th and 19th August).

What do you need to be in this production? We are looking for a cast with energy, fun, stage presence, good vocal ability, movement and the dedication to give what it takes to be in musical theatre. You will be given an exciting opportunity to perform in the production under the guidance of West End professionals, as part of the Biz Theatre School's Summer School Production. With a time constraint of only 2 weeks, it will be exciting to see the musical taking shape. The students will be involved in acting, singing and dancing. It will be hard work but with a strong emphasis on enjoyment for all! We will produce an exciting show and we will endeavour to ensure that the 2 weeks are great fun! The course, which takes place Monday to Friday between 9 am and 4 pm, (plus extra rehearsals 2nd week) will help the participants to develop confidence and performance skills and comprises of 10 days of enthusiastic and busy rehearsals and preparation towards the climax of performances on the Friday and the Saturday in the theatre, utilising the skills learned during the course.

Places to take part in **CATS** are by audition only, no previous musical theatre experience is necessary, but you must be talented and prepared to sing, dance and act in front of a panel at your audition and a love of performing is essential. We will also hold re-call auditions for those who we are considering for a principal role.

We have had the first round of auditions already, and had an overwhelming response, but don't worry there is still time to be considered if you **apply to us as soon as possible with an application form!** All parts are still open although recalls are currently being arranged so don't delay-**apply now!**

Parents are welcome to wait in the College outside the auditions, parents will not be allowed to accompany children into their audition. There will be a licensed chaperone present on the day to supervise children auditioning and to supervise anyone waiting to be collected.

Audition Criteria

You must be aged 8 up to the age of 21

- You must be prepared to sing, dance and act at your audition in front of the panel and other people auditioning
- You must be available for all dates of the project outlined above
- You must be able to get yourself to and from Christ's College for rehearsals and Rhoda McGaw Theatre for show performances

Auditions are by application only and forms must be received by The Biz Theatre before the audition date. Please note that due to the volume of audition application forms we receive you may not receive an acknowledgement back from us, you just need to turn up at the correct time as confirmed.

The Biz CATS Fees If you are successful at your audition, the fees to take part in **CATS** are:

£275 if you confirm by the **Monday 21st May**. (£325 after that date) and includes Rehearsals, hire of scripts, music, most costumes, Chaperones, Souvenir T-Shirt and performances at the Rhoda McGaw Theatre.

If you are successful at your audition you will be notified by email and you will be required to pay a deposit of **£95 by 21st May** to secure your place, with the remainder due to be paid by **Monday 2nd July**.

To perform in CATS you may also be required to provide, and on some occasions purchase a small amount of costume items such as shoes. We will endeavour to keep costs down as much as possible.

Please note that we do have a limited number of bursaries available to cast members. The bursaries are awarded to those who apply from the lowest income families to cover the participant fee. Application forms will be available on request once you have successfully auditioned.

Frequently asked questions:

How to register Please complete the application form below in full and return asap to: THE BIZ COLUMBYNE HOUSE, PINE ROAD, WOKING, SURREY GU22 0DX. Or alternatively you can fill in or scan and email your application to enquiries@thebizgroup.co.uk

How much does it cost to audition? Auditions are completely free of charge. If selected to take part in CATS there will be a fee as outlined above, bursaries are available.

Does everyone who applies get an audition? Yes, if you register for an audition by returning the application form along to us asap you are eligible to audition, please note that due to the number of applications we receive you may not get a confirmation acknowledgement of your application form.

Do I need to prepare anything for my audition? We recommend that you have a basic knowledge of the most popular songs from CATS prior to your audition and be prepared to sing and dance. Full casting and audition details attached.

What do I need to wear for my audition? Please make sure you wear loose comfortable clothing that you can dance in and trainers or dance shoes. Please keep jewellery to a minimum and if you have long hair please tie this back.

What is a re-call? Selected auditionees will be invited to attend our re-call auditions. The re-call auditions are to cast the principal roles in CATS. If you have not been asked to attend the re-call day you may still have been cast in an ensemble role and please note that the director's decision is final.

What happens after my audition? You will be emailed with information on whether you have been given a role in CATS, are on our reserve list (in case any places become available) or whether you have been unsuccessful.

Tickets for the performances will be on sale from March onwards. Ticket prices are expected to be around £16 each (including 50p theatre restoration levy). It is hoped that any profits from the performances will go to **SHOOTINGSTAR CHASE, CHILDREN'S HOSPICE FOR SURREY**. We have already raised over **£34,000** for local Charities with our previous productions.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- I understand that, if offered a place in the Company for 2018 the student is required to attend all rehearsals and performances. Students will need to be available for 2 weeks - all day Monday Friday from **9.00 am – 4 pm**. N.B. some cast and principals may be required to stay later second week tbc.
- Week 1 will be at **Christ's College, Larch Avenue, Guildford, Surrey GU1 1JY**. (Fantastic performing arts facilities conveniently situated between Woking and Guildford and near to A3) Week 2 will be at the Rhoda McGaw Theatre (from Monday for production days).
- In addition to the rehearsals there will be performances at the theatre on **Friday 24th August at 7.15pm, Saturday 25th August at 2.15pm and 7.15pm** (also dress rehearsal **Thursday 23rd August 7.15pm**)
- The course will start at **9.00am** every morning and finishes promptly at **4pm** (until Week 2 when they may be asked to stay later). Arrangements must be made for the above named to be collected at the stated time of finish of any given session. The Biz will not accept responsibility for any child who leaves any rehearsal premises without seeking permission from an appropriate teacher. If your child is making his or her own way home or leaving the premises at Lunchtime, you must sign permission slips. These will be provided upon acceptance and are available for candidates over the age of 12
- You must provide a full packed lunch for your child each day and snacks and drinks etc.
- The full fee is due in full before the start of the course and cannot be waived in respect to any absence. No refunds will be given.
